1. The meeting was called to order at 6:20 p.m.
2. Joe announced that Clark Beech had resigned from the Youth Commission. That left a vacancy in District 1.
3. On a motion by Cindy and seconded by Sara, the minutes for the March 14 agenda were approved.
4. Sober Grad Night Planning:
The booth needs to be staffed from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. There can be three shifts of 2 hours each or two shifts of 3 hours each. Commissioners need to check their schedules to see which shift they will

sign up for. The following checklist for setup and flyer information was agreed upon by all:
